1 THE COURT: eCom eCom.com, Inc. We have a post
2 confirmation status conference and also an application
3 for first and final compensation by Wieseneck, Andres and
4 Company. Mr. Berger is going to appear by phone. Give
5 me a moment.

6 (The Court contacted Mr. Berger by telephone.)

7 THE COURT: Mr. Berger, I'm calling on the
8 matter of eCom eCom.com, Inc. Scheduled today is a post
9 confirmation status conversation, which has been
10 continued a couple of times, and also there is an
11 application for first and final compensation filed by
12 Wieseneck Andres and Company, who is the auditor. Mr.
13 Berger, you represent the debtor.

14 MR. BERGER: Yes, Your Honor.

15 MR. TURNER: I'm Richard Turner, treasurer of
16 the debtor.

17 THE COURT: That's right, of course, Mr.
18 Turner. Thank you. And Ms. Heffner, you are here on
19 behalf of the United States Trustee's Office.

20 MS. HEFFNER: Yes, Your Honor.

21 MR. BERGER: Your Honor, there are two pending
22 matters that basically needed to get wrapped up prior to
23 filing the final report and motion for order closing
24 case.

25 The first is the application of Wieseneck

1 Andres and Company that is set for today, and the second
2 was the resolution of a claim filed by Patricia A. Finch
3 Junk (phonetic).

4 We had entered a consensual agreed order with
5 the claimant resolving that claim, and we had originally
6 served it via regular mail. However, the order requested
7 that we serve it via certified mail, which we have now
8 done, and the 20 day time period to object has subsided.
9 So that matter has now been resolved.

10 THE COURT: And what will be the disposition of
11 Ms. Johnson's (sic) claim?

12 MR. BERGER: Ms. Junk is to receive a
13 distribution of -- let me give you the exact number, Your
14 Honor, she is to receive a disbursement of \$292.44 in a
15 lump sum.

16 THE COURT: And is that based upon a pending
17 objection to claim?

18 MR. BERGER: Yes. There was an objection
19 filed, and the debtor and the claimant reached a
20 resolution, and an agreed order was filed -- was entered
21 by this Court on June 26th, 2007 --

22 THE COURT: So I have already entered an order
23 on that claim objection?

24 MR. BERGER: Correct, Your Honor. The order
25 basically provided that the claimant would have 20 days

1 for rehearing in the event that the claimant disagreed
2 with the terms. The claimant was served via regular mail
3 and certified mail, and the claimant does not object to
4 the terms in the order.

5 THE COURT: I see. Very well. Then that
6 matter is taken care of. And then the other matter is
7 this pending fee application.

8 MR. BERGER: Correct, Your Honor.

9 THE COURT: And the fee application is in the
10 amount of \$7,163.75. No expenses.

11 MR. BERGER: That is correct, Your Honor. It
12 covers the time period from January 30th, 2006 to January
13 of 2007. We have received no objections to this
14 application.

15 THE COURT: Ms. Heffner, do you have any
16 comments?

17 MS. HEFFNER: Your Honor, I have no objection
18 to the fee application.

19 THE COURT: Then I will enter an order -- I'll
20 ask you to submit an order, Mr. Berger, allowing the fees
21 in the amount of \$7,163.75, and authorizing reimbursement
22 of expenses -- actually, there is no reimbursement of
23 expenses sought, it's just the fees.

24 MR. BERGER: Correct. And I will upload an
25 order to that effect, Your Honor.

1 THE COURT: Thank you. Now, with the entry of
2 the order on fees, coupled with the order that's already
3 been entered as to the claim of Ms. Johnson, is this case
4 now in a posture where a motion for final decree can be
5 submitted?

6 MR. BERGER: Yes, Your Honor. And now that
7 those two matters have been taken care of, we are going
8 to file with the Court our final report and a motion for
9 an order closing the case.

10 THE COURT: Very well. Ms. Heffner.

11 MS. HEFFNER: Your Honor, I would ask that you
12 set a status hearing for this motion for final decree.
13 Some things in this case have taken much, much, much
14 longer than they should have, and I'd like to be assured
15 that this is going to get filed in a timely manner.

16 THE COURT: Well, wouldn't it be better then if
17 I simply continued the post confirmation status
18 conference?

19 MS. HEFFNER: That's fine. Just so we have a
20 date.

21 THE COURT: And I assume you'd be looking for a
22 date in what, 60 days?

23 MS. HEFFNER: That would be very good, Your
24 Honor, yes. Thank you.

25 THE COURT: I'll see that an order is done.

1 This case will be reassigned, and I'll see that the
2 matter is set. Mr. Turner, is there anything you wanted
3 to add?

4 MR. TURNER: No. Everything is going well.

5 THE COURT: Mr. Berger?

6 MR. BERGER: That's all we have, Your Honor.

7 THE COURT: Very well. Thank you very much.

8 Have a good day.

9 MR. BERGER: Thank you, Your Honor.

10 MS. HEFFNER: Thank you, Your Honor.

11 (The proceedings were concluded.)

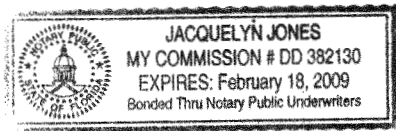
